RADIO COMMUNICATIONS: COMMITTEE CHAIRMEN WILL HAVE RADIOS FOR COMMUNICATING PROBLEMS AND QUESTIONS TO DIVISION DIRECTORS AND PGA TOUR STAFF

HOLE CAPTAINS

- Captains are the first line of inquiry for any questions/problems
- HOLE CAPTAINS WILL HAVE RADIOS

GENERAL MARSHAL DUTIES

- CRITICAL TO THE SUCCESS OF THE TOURNAMENT
- PLAYER SUPPORT
- PROBLEM SOLVERS
- FACE OF THE CHARLES SCHWAB CUP CHAMPIONSHIP
- CROWD CONTROL



SPECIFIC DUTIES OF MARSHALS

- PRACTICE AREA: PHOENIX COUNTRY CLUB DRIVING RANGE. THIS AREA IS MANAGED BY PRACTICE AREA COMMITTEE
- ON-COURSE MARSHALS: TEE BOX, LANDING AREAS, AND PUTTING GREEN
- HAND SIGNALS
 - FIRST AID/SAFETY
 - CROWD CONTROL
 - BALL DIRECTION

FACE THE CROWD

TEE BOX

- Make unobstructed path to tee box
- CROWD CONTROL
 - BE MINDFUL OF CROWD ACTIVITY (VOLUNTEERS, STAFF, VENDORS, ETC.)
 - Use best judgement
 - Position yourself correctly, FACE THE CROWD, raise hands, quiet crowd
- BE MINDFUL OF OTHER GREENS, TEE BOXES, PLAYERS IN SURROUNDING AREA
- DESIGNATE MARSHAL TO SIGNAL TO LANDING AREA MARSHALS

LANDING AREA

- LOCATE ERRANT TEE SHOTS
- CROWD CONTROL
 - BE MINDFUL OF CROWD ACTIVITY (VOLUNTEERS, STAFF, VENDORS, ETC.)
 - Use best judgement
 - Position yourself correctly, FACE THE CROWD, raise hands, quiet crowd
- Pay attention to ball flight and landing in the rough; mark with flags
- DO NOTHING IF BALL IS IN FAIRWAY
- OUT OF BOUNDS

PUTTING GREEN

- CROWD CONTROL
 - BE MINDFUL OF CROWD ACTIVITY (VOLUNTEERS, STAFF, VENDORS, ETC.)
 - Use best judgement
 - Position yourself correctly, FACE THE CROWD, raise hands, quiet crowd
- Be mindful of your position near the Green, do not interfere with line of sight
- LOCATE WAYWARD SHOTS OFF GREEN

MISCELLANEOUS

EVACUATION: PLAYERS AND CADDIES WILL USE PRE-STAGED GOLF CARTS

CROSSWALKS: CROSSWALKS WILL BE THROUGHOUT THE COURSE

ON-COURSE RULINGS: NOT OUR JOB

Work shifts: Hole Captains to provide schedules, show-up times, ending times;

ALLOW SUFFICIENT TIME TO ARRIVE AT YOUR HOLE ON TIME

MISCELLANEOUS

Pre-play meetings on each hole: hole captains to schedule and convene, near but not on tee box or green: be on time

 - Playoff Holes for Charles Schwab Cup: 16,17,18
 - AGGREGATE SCORE
