Tickets now on sale for 2018 Charles Schwab Cup Championship *Pro-Am spots remain available for Charles Schwab Cup Playoffs finale*

PHOENIX, Arizona – The Charles Schwab Cup Championship announced today that tickets are now on sale for the 2018 event, which will be played at Phoenix Country Club from Nov. 7-11. In addition to tickets going on sale, Wednesday Pro-Am spots are also available for the final event in the Charles Schwab Cup Playoffs, which features the top 36 players on the Charles Schwab Cup points list and decides the overall season champion.

For a second consecutive year, Thunderbird Charities will sponsor free admittance to spectators on Wednesday of the Charles Schwab Cup Championship. Starting Thursday, daily grounds tickets will be available for \$25 with weekly passes going for just \$65. On October 8, prices will increase to \$30 for daily grounds and \$75 for weekly passes. Youth 18 years of age and under are admitted free all week with a ticketed adult. The youth policy applies only to Good Any One Day grounds tickets and excludes access to private hospitality venues.

“Momentum continues to build as the Charles Schwab Cup Championship nears its second year at Phoenix Country Club,” said Executive Director Tiffany Nelson. “This tournament prides itself on providing an affordable, memorable experience for new and returning fans to witness legends of the sport compete for the ultimate prize at one of the game’s premier venues.”

New in 2018, the Cold Beer and Cheeseburgers Lounge ticket offer is an upgraded experience featured for fans providing a VIP viewing area with premium food and beverage for purchase. This venue will also feature “\$1 Birdie Beers”. A daily pass for the CBCB Lounge located on the 12th green is available for \$40 through October 7, with weekly passes going for \$160. Starting on October 8, prices will undergo a slight increase to \$50 daily and \$200 weekly.

All active duty and Reserve, military retirees, and their dependents also receive free entry all week. Military ticket includes access to the Birdies for the Brave® Patriots' Outpost hospitality chalet presented by United Rentals. The Outpost is open Thursday-Sunday of tournament week located on the 13th green. Complimentary food and beverages are provided. Tickets are complimentary but a \$1 verification fee per military individual does apply. Link to military tickets –

For an upgraded experience, the 1899 Club provides guests with exclusive access to the historic Phoenix Country Club clubhouse. The 1899 Club, with its indoor/outdoor seating and great views of 1 and 10 tees, the practice green, and the 18th green from the clubhouse veranda, is truly a member-like experience. A 4-pack of tickets which includes four (4) tickets per day (Thursday – Sunday), is available for \$5,000. The 1899 Club also provides on-course access to a second hospitality venue that showcases incredible golf views of multiple holes, most notably the par-3 15th, which features a dramatic tee shot over water.

Earlier this year, PGA TOUR Champions Player Advisory Council and the Player Directors unanimously voted in favor of changing the tournament format from 54-holes to a 72-hole event. In addition to the extra round of competition for players, the change also means more golf for fans. Spectators are given an additional day to indulge in a variety of fan features the Charles Schwab Cup Championship has to offer. Thursday through Sunday, fans are encouraged to venture out on course to witness great views of golf at the prestigious venue in the heart of downtown Phoenix. Patrons can visit the Four Peaks Brewery for a premium craft beer, the Vineyard for a signature Froze (frozen rose) or experience the food trucks, showcasing local Phoenix restaurants at your fingertips.

Amateur spots in the Official Pro-Am are still available. This event provides the ultimate corporate entertaining experience and offers the opportunity to participate and enjoy the excitement of playing with a PGA TOUR Champions player. Contested on Wednesday of tournament week, Pro-Am participants sold in teams of four (4) are granted the following:
